



# TRI-CO HORSE CENTER RULES

1. Maximum horse camping on OPEN sites will be limited to two (2) weeks, after which the unit must be removed from the horse center for at least one week. Only two (2) periods of two (2) weeks camping per year are permitted in the OPEN camping area, unless otherwise approved by the Trustees.
2. No unlicensed vehicles are permitted on the Horse Center property. No storing of vehicles on campsites.
3. Maximum speed within the Horse Center is 10 mph.
4. No horses or other animals are allowed within 50 feet of the pavilion. White rings on surrounding trees mark these areas.
5. ALL dogs must be kept on a leash or confined while on Horse Center property. NO dogs allowed on any trail.
6. No permanent connections to the water hydrants permitted. Once unit is filled, they must be disconnected.
7. On reserved sites, no electric is to be left on unless you are there. You may hook up 24 hours before you camp, but electric must be disconnected when you leave.
8. On reserved sites, no air-conditioning or heater hook-ups are permitted.
9. Running of generators, or riding of horses in the Horse Center after midnight is prohibited. Midnight is designated as "Quiet Time". The generators can be turned back on at 6am.
10. The racing of horses on Horse Center property, except in association organized, is prohibited.
11. Hunting or discharging of any firearms on the Horse Center property and trails is strictly prohibited.
12. There will be no clearing of any trees from anywhere on the Horse Center property without Trustees Approval. Replacement fee for damaged tree(s) will be \$150 each.
13. Painting of anything at the Horse Center in any color other than earth tones (example: dark browns or dark greens) is prohibited.
14. All campsites, including reserved sites must be kept clean and orderly, subject to approval of the Trustees.
15. All trash and garbage must be placed in the dumpster provided for trash removal. If a member uses the Horse Center trash dumpster for personal use, they will be charged \$60.00 for trash removal.
16. All manure should be put in the manure spreader and not in the woods. If the manure spreader is full or not present, take it home.

17. Substance Abuse: The possession of any illegal substances on the properties owned or leased by Tri-County Trail Association is strictly forbidden. Any violations will be dispatched to the appropriate law enforcement agency. Tri-Co is and will continue to be in good moral standing in the community.
18. No outside lights will be more than 25 watts and all camper lights must be covered.
19. No portable corrals on the Horse Center property.
20. If any dog in camp bites someone (human or animal), you will be asked to remove said dog from camp and the dog warden will be notified.
21. Camping and riding at the Horse Center shall be done at your own risk. The Association will not be responsible for any accident or injury to any member, guest or horse while participating in any association activity or while using Association facilities at non-association organized times held under the Ohio Equine Law.
22. All camping must be horse related.
23. All fire rings must be a minimum of 10 feet from any structure or camper.

## **ASSOCIATION ORGANIZED RIDE RULES**

1. No stallions will be permitted on any Association organized activity, or on Horse Center property during the time Association activities are taking place.
2. The designated Trail Boss/Guide shall be in complete control of the trail ride and should be in the lead of the ride at all times. No passing the Trail Boss/Guide.
3. A designates Drag rider should be at the end of all Association organized trial rides.
4. Road guards should be designated for all rides with 20 or more riders.
5. Riders should stay with the main body, unless cleared by the Trail Boss/Guide and leaving only after the main body pulls out.
6. All known "kickers" should have a red ribbon on their tails.
7. No firearms will be permitted on any organized trial ride.
8. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on any organized trail ride.
9. No littering on the trails.
10. No Children under 14 are permitted on trail rides unless accompanied by either a parent or a responsible person.
