



TRI-CO PARADE DRESS CODE/RULES

Person:

1. Must be a current Tri-Co Member.
2. A min of 16 years old, for HOF Parade only.
3. White straw hat.
4. Tri-Co scarf (if issued at parade)
5. Nice white short sleeve button up with collar, (western preferred) tucked into jeans. (unless other wise directed by parade chairperson).
6. Western type jeans.
7. Blue jean (as new as possible), free of holes, worn over boots (preferred black or brown boots).
8. All should be neat and clean.

Horse & Equipment:

1. Well - mannered horse and well groomed.
2. Western trail saddles, clean.
3. Clean saddle pad.
4. Tri-Co roll on back of saddle (if issued at parade).
5. NO saddle bags, canteens, machetes, guns or anything else hanging from saddle.
6. Natural hooves (not blackened)
7. NO Studs.

Extras:

1. Be on time at the designated meeting place.
2. Must be clean, sober and well groomed.
3. No drinking or smoking once we are lined up.
4. No chewing gum or eating once we are lined up.
5. Must keep horses in line up when in parade route. **NO Spining horses at any time.
6. If horse is having trouble while in route, dismount immediately and walk your horse the rest of the route for safety.
7. To ride in the HOF Grand parade, you must ride in at least 2 other parades with Tri-Co so your horse can be ready for the XL parade.

Remember:

You represent Tri-County Trail Association. The parade chair person has the authority to dismiss anyone from any parade who does not comply to the above rules.
